
Learn about DIALECT 4!

DIALECT 4 is a Europe-wide initiative that uses football to fight radicalization and promote inclusion among children (10–12 years old) and youth (13–17 years old). It builds on 5 years of success in Greece, Italy, Hungary, and Serbia with the DIALECT methodology.

This European initiative forms mixed football teams by bringing together children from diverse ethnic and cultural backgrounds.

Participation is inclusive and open to all children, regardless of gender, creating a space where collaboration and mutual respect are central.

A key objective of the project is to expand local action groups of children and youth, encouraging inter-age learning and mentorship. This community-based approach strengthens efforts to combat racism and intolerance at the grassroots level.



Enhancing Trainers' Skills

DIALECT 4 strengthens the capacities of mediators and trainers across four partner countries to effectively engage children, building their resilience to extremist views through media literacy and inclusive football activities.

Forming Children's Football Teams at Local Level

Establish local children's football teams in the four partner countries using an adapted methodology designed to enhance critical thinking, self-determination, and media literacy skills.

Strengthening Existing DIALECT Youth Teams

Continue working with existing youth football teams to support lasting changes in attitudes and behavior, giving adolescents the time and guidance they need to grow.

Bringing Together Children and Youth

Promote inter-age learning and mentoring by bringing together children and youth through youth-led local actions that foster acceptance, respect, and inclusion.
